



Your Path to a SUNY Bachelor's Degree

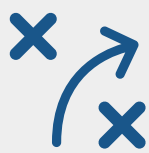

Explore

Two Years Before Transfer

Two Years Before Transfer

One Year Before Transfer

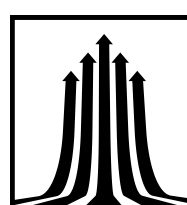
Apply to your chosen campus, complete your FAFSA, and review your complete and in-progress coursework with your current advisor and an advisor at your chosen campus.
